Biography

Stefán Víkingur is an American Icelandic tenor. He is currently studying Vocal performance at the University of Arizona Fred Fox School of Music under Dr. Andrew Stuckey. Last year, Stefán performed in Belle Ile, France with the French opera festival "Lyrique En Mer" Under the direction of stage director Robert Chevara and conductor Phillip Walsh. He has performed a number of operas and opera scenes at the University of Arizona including Gianni Schicci (Marco), Dido And Aenaes (The Sorceress), and Carmen (Le Dancaïre) with stage director Cynthia Stokes and conductor Thomas Cockerel. This composition, a finalist piece from the Dominick Argento Chamber Opera Competition, was performed at the National Opera Association Conference in Tempe, Arizona. Next fall, Stefán plans to spend a semester at the Conservatorio Rossini in Pesaro Italy.
